## **NOTICE OF RACE**

---

### **1 RULES**

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2012*.
- 1.2 For protests where only a Rule of Part 2 is alleged to have been broken an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.

### **2 ADVERTISING**

- 2.1 Advertising will be restricted to Category A.
- 2.2 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

### **3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Jollyboat Class.
- 3.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached form and sending it, together with the required fee, to FBYC by 31<sup>st</sup> October 2010. See requirement 5.1 re Entry Fees.
- 3.3 Late entries will be accepted under the following conditions: A late entry fee of and additional \$20 will apply for entries made after November 1<sup>st</sup> 2010.
- 3.4 To be eligible to compete in this event each entrant shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the entrant's national authority.

**3.5** Each entrant shall be a current member of the Jollyboat Class Association.

**3.6** Personal buoyancy aids are to be worn at all times whilst afloat by all competitors.

## **5 FEES**

**5.1** Required fees are as follows:

\$50 per boat single handed

\$50 per boat double handed

Payable to French Bay Yacht Club, Inc. See entry form for details.

## **6 REGATTA SCHEDULE**

**6.1** Registration:

Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> November

From 8 am

**6.2** Dates of racing:

Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> November

- high tide 1100, anticipated first race 1000.

Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> November

- high tide 1200, anticipated first race 1030.

**6.3** Number of races:

There are 3 races scheduled for Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> November and 2 races scheduled for Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> November.

**6.4** On Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> November no warning signal will be made after 1400 hours.

## **7 MEASUREMENTS**

All boats should be available for weighing from 9am Saturday 6<sup>th</sup>

November. Spot weighing may take place at the discretion of the PRO after completion of any of the races.

## 8 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at FBYC on Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> November or by notification through the Jollyboat Class Association newsgroup and website [www.jollyboat.co.nz](http://www.jollyboat.co.nz)

## 9 VENUE

9.1 The map below shows the location of the regatta venue.



9.2 The location of the racing area will be off French Bay to be confirmed by the PRO.

## 10 THE COURSES

The courses are as attached. Flags 1, 2, 3 or 4 will designate which course is to be sailed together with a red or green flag to designate a port or starboard course, flown from the committee boat. An ocean race may be advised by the PRO.



**13 SUPPORT BOATS**

Support boats shall be identified at the briefing by the PRO.

**14 BERTHING / PARKING**

Boats and road trailers shall be kept in the assigned area in the FBYC boat park. Security will be provided by FBYC overnight.

**LAUNCHING**

Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from FBYC ramp or French Bay beach.

**15 PRIZES**

Prizes will be given as follows:

1st-3rd Single Handed

1st-3rd Double Handed

Handicap Trophy
