## ***Notice of Race***

**The Organising Authority is the Torbay Sailing Club (TSC)**

**Note:** The notation '[DP]' in a rule in a rule in the Notice of Race means that the penalty for a breach of that rule may, at the discretion of the protest committee, be less than disqualification.

#### **1. Rules**

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing ("RRS").
- 1.2. The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply.
- 1.3. Appendix S shall apply.
- 1.4. Appendix T shall apply.

#### **2. Advertising**

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organising Authority.

#### **3. Eligibility and Entry**

- 3.1. The regatta is open to boats of the Sunburst and Jollyboat classes.
- 3.2. Eligible skippers may enter by completing the attached form and either

- 3.3. Late entries. A late entry may be accepted at the Organising Authority's discretion until 1000hrs on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> March 2020. (T-Shirts not included).

3.4. To be eligible to compete in this event each entrant and crew member shall be a financial member of a club recognised by their national authority. Proof of affiliated club member is to be submitted with the entry or presented at the time of registration.

4.1. The entry fee for all classes is \$150.00

##### 5.5. Number of Races

###### (a) Sunburst Class

- i. 9 Races are scheduled for the series.
- ii. The winner of Race 1 in the Championship fleet shall be awarded the Invitation Race Trophy.
- iii. The above applies to the Championship and Taihoa (non-spinnaker) fleets.

###### (b) Jollyboat Class

- i. 9 Races are scheduled for the series.

(c) Up to 4 races may be sailed per day.

(d) The target time for each race will be 45 minutes for the leading boat.

(e) On Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> March no warning signal will be made after 1530hrs

##### 5.6 Jollyboat AGM

Friday 20<sup>th</sup> March after completion of racing or as the schedule permits.

##### 5.7 Evening Meal and Social Event

Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> March following the completion of racing. Time TBA.

#### 6. Measurement

##### 6.1 Sunburst Class

6.1.1 Each boat shall have a valid measurement certificate and shall display a current registration sticker on its transom.

6.1.2 All sails shall have been previously measured and stamped by a Sunburst Class Measurer.

6.1.3 Each competitor shall present their hull for weighing in dry condition with the rudder stock removed.

6.1.4 There shall be only one set of sails, spars and foils used by each boat. These shall be presented and endorsed at Measurement. (refer NOR5.1 above).

Any changes must be requested and approved by the Race Officer in writing.

6.1.5 Each boat shall complete a measurement/safety checklist during the measurement process.

Entrants are encouraged to undertake this process on Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> March due to the tight time constraints on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> March. (refer NOR5.1 above).

6.1.6.1 There will be no sail, boat or foil measurement at the event unless previously arranged with a Sunburst Class Measurer.

## 6.2 Jollyboat Class

6.2.1.1 Each boat shall have a valid measurement certificate.

6.2.1.2 Each boat shall produce a valid Jollyboat WOF at the time of registration and display a 2019-2020 WOF sticker on its transom.

6.2.1.3 Measurement and WOF checks will be available during scheduled measurement (refer NOR5.1 above) and must be pre-booked with the Class Measurer.

6.3 All beach trailers/trolleys must have boat names and numbers clearly marked on them.

6.4 Safety and measurement checks may be made on any boat at any time during the event.

## 7. **Sailing Instructions**

7.1. Printed Sailing Instructions will not be made available. The Supplementary Sailing Instructions will be posted on the TSC website by 0900 on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> March 2020 and will also be posted on the Official Notice Board.

## 8. **Venue**

8.1. Attachment A shows the location of the regatta venue.

8.2. The Racing area is the waters off Waiake Beach, Torbay.

## 9. **Courses to be Sailed**

9.1. The courses to be sailed will be triangular courses including windward, reaching and leeward marks.

## 10. **Penalty System**

10.1. Rule 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that the 'Two-Turns' penalty is replaced by the 'One-Turn' Penalty.

## 11. **Scoring**

11.1. 5 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

11.2. When fewer than 6 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

11.3. When 6 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

## 12. **Launching**

12.1 Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from Waiake Beach.

## 13. **Coaching and Support Boats**

13.1. Support boats are allowed.

## 14. **Radio Communication**

14.1. Except in an emergency, a boat that is racing shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones. [DP].

## 15. **Prizes**

15.1. Prizes will be awarded as follows:

- Brooke Trophy (2<sup>nd</sup> line)
- Maurice Scott & Life Members' Trophy (3<sup>rd</sup> Line)
- Wakatere Trophy (1<sup>st</sup> Handicap)
- Colin & Peter Kettlewell Cup (1<sup>st</sup> Helm & Crew under 19 years of age at 20<sup>th</sup> March 2020)
- National Youth Championship Mixed Double Handed Trophy (Helm & Crew under 19 years of age at 20<sup>th</sup> March 2020)
- NZ Sunburst Association Trophy – Secondary Schools Trophy (1<sup>st</sup> Helm & Crew both pupils from the same school on 20<sup>th</sup> March 2020)
- Muritai One Ton Cup (Highest placed crew with a combined age of 100 years or more).
- Invitation Race Trophy – John Brooke painting

- Tony Bouzaid Trophy

#### Jollyboat

- 1<sup>st</sup> Single Handed Trophy
- 1<sup>st</sup> Double Handed Trophy
- 1<sup>st</sup> Handicap Trophy
- Overall & National Champion (Salad Bowl) - Awarded to the crew with the lowest points
- 1<sup>st</sup> Club Team (Munted Mermaid) – Awarded to the Team representing an affiliated yacht club whose three (3) boats combined overall points total the lowest
- Furthestmost travelled crew
- Oldest crew – Combined age of a 2-person crew
- Youngest crew – Combined age of a 2-person crew

15.2. Other prizes may be awarded at the discretion of the Organising Authority.

#### **16. Insurance**

16.1 **It is highly recommended that each participating boat be insured with valid marine third-party liability insurance of a minimum of \$1,000,000.**

#### **17. Disclaimer of Liability**

17.1 Competitors participate in all races entirely at their own risk. Refer to RRS rule 4. The Organising Authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the race.
